Shipyard: Lhotka nad Labem 86, 410 01 Lovosice, Czech Republic,

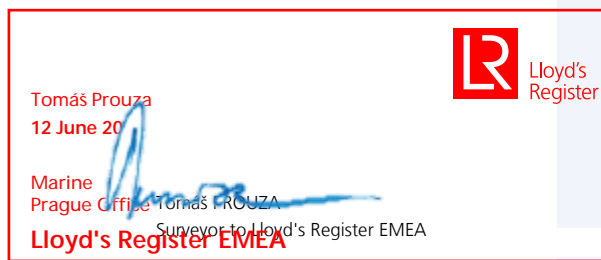
- 1. Workshops including production facilities (cutting and bending machines).**

- 3. Handling of material used for construction and its traceability during whole production process.**
- 4. Welding and cutting equipment.**
- 5. Welders qualification for welding of carbon and stainless steel.**
- 6. Approved welding procedures for welding of carbon and stainless steel.**
- 7. NDT procedures owned by Shipyard, qualified NDT personnel is subcontracted.**
- 8. Capability and personnel qualification of quality control department and shipyard design department.**
- 9. Organisation structure including position of Quality Control Department, Quality Manual.**
- 10. Availability of Lloyd's Register rules and regulations for Inland Waterway Ships.**
- 11. Implementation of IACS URZ 23 verified.**
